

WHARFINGER HOUSE - Built in the 1920s for the harbour master, a classical tropical design now restored.

DERBY PICTURE GARDENS - The warm tropical nights add enjoyment to regular screenings of current movies.

STANLEY SQUARE - Administrative heart of Derby. Grassy park with big boab tree and shipwreck relics.

OLD DERBY GAOL - Built of mud and corrugated iron by prisoners in the 1880s and now renovated.

KING SOUND - Extensive mud flats covered only by the highest tides. Rivers and inlets provide magnificent scenery, excellent barramundi fishing and crocodile views. Tides make boating treacherous. See Crocodile Warning.

PIGEON HERITAGE TRAIL - Named after a famous Aborigine, the self-driving trail aims to depict relations between Aborigines and Europeans in the 1890s. Information from the Derby Tourist Bureau.

BOTANICAL GARDENS - Adjoining the Art Gallery, this shady oasis has local trees and exotic palms.

DERBY CULTURAL CENTRE - Houses the library and art gallery. This centre is constructed of local sandstone.

ROYAL FLYING DOCTOR BASE - Radio and staff base for West Kimberley service. Open to visitors weekdays, souvenirs for sale.

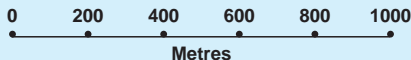
SCHOOL OF THE AIR - Teachers hold lessons by radio with outback children. Visits best before 10 am.
